## 2015 CLAY TOWN\$HIP FINANCIAL REPORT

March 8, 2016 Report to Annual Meeting Key financial details for 2015:

EXPENSES FROM ROAD & BRIDGE LEVY = \$23,121.49. Of this, \$20,608.99 was for all non-snow related maintenance of Clay's roads. Major regraveling and repair occurs for each road every four years on a rotating schedule. First half of Jasmine was re-graveled and repaired at \$10,037.50, 290<sup>th</sup> at \$5,928.75, and \$1007.50 to replace Jigsaw culvert were part of the total Road and Bridge expenses. Rotation schedule: (a) Second half of Jasmine, (b) First mile of Jasmine and 290<sup>th</sup> from highway four to old Rosenberg house, and spot gravel to grader turnaround, (c) Jewel, (d) Jigsaw, (e) repeat. Snow removal and sanding were \$2,512.50 of the total Road and Bridge expense, which is significantly less than prior years.

EXPENSES FROM GENERAL LEVY = \$24,726.47. This figure does not include \$9,987.21 dedicated to our (041) Building Levy and earmarked as such by the County / State. Wages and Reimbursements were \$7,110.03. Assessor fees: \$3,885.32, Fire Contract: \$2,820.16; Other expenses included Insurance: \$2,054.00; Contracts for Service: \$3,200 which includes \$1,800 to check boats for AIS on Mantrap, with the rest made up of Office supplies, Postage, Required newspaper notices in the Enterprise, Donations to Library and Historical Society, & Mantrap Valley Conservation Club for building use.

TOTAL ALL 2015 LEVIES: \$57,835.17 which includes \$9,987.21 ) earmarked by the County / State for Building Levy income (041).

INCOME: We began 2015 with a \$106,046.47 balance in all accounts, including the dedicated Building Fund of \$35,683.37. INCOME totaled \$97,259.39 from all sources in 2015 including one time income of \$33,259.17 for Tax Forfeit Land, which the County Auditor advised NOT to be budgeted for future expenses. After subtracting all bills submitted and paid in 2015, we started 2016 with \$109,786.39 Operating Fund which does NOT include a total dedicated Building Fund (041) of \$45,670.58. Without adjustment to account for the one time TFL payment, our 2016 Operating Balance of \$109,786.39 puts us in very good standing with

the Minnesota Association of Townships recommendations and guidelines.
